Peggy Badenhausen received her M.Ed. in Art Education from Temple University. She studied printmaking and painting at Montserrat School of Visual Arts, Beverly, MA and at the Tyler School of Art, Rome, Italy. She has been a repeat Visiting Artist at the American Academy in Rome, Italy.

Her work has been shown in solo and group gallery exhibitions nationally. Ms. Badenhausen's work is in many public collections including the Fogg Art Museum, Cambridge, MA, DeCordova Museum and Sculpture Park, Lincoln, MA, Boston College, Chestnut Hill, MA, Putnam Investments, Boston, MA and is also included in private collections in Canada, Italy, France, Great Britain as well as in the USA.
