Soprafina Gallery is pleased to announce our sixth solo exhibition of new paintings by Robin Reynolds.

Ms. Reynolds is a plein air painter weaving a relationship between abstraction and representation. She challenges her interpretation of nature and allows the painting to take precedence. She is not concerned with a literal depiction of the landscape, but rather a sense of place, carefully constructed to form her vision of nature. Her new series is vibrant and inspired by the shapes and colors in flowers and in gardens.

The results of Ms. Reynolds creative effort is a new series of colorful, visually and spiritually uplifting paintings. And during the winter months Robin has explored collage. We're pleased to have a few at this exhibition.

Robin Reynolds received her M.F.A. from Savannah College of Art & Design. She has further studied at the Stonington Painters Workshop, Stonington, ME., the Dorland Mountain Arts Colony, Temecula, CA, the Millay Colony for the Arts, Austerlitz, NY, the Syracuse University & Fortman Studios in Florence, Italy and the Vermont Studio School, Johnson VT.

Ms. Reynolds has been the recipient of prestigious recent awards including the Best of Show at the ARTSWorcester Biennial, juried by Nicholas J. Capasso, when he was curator at the DeCordova Museum and Best Oil Painting Award at the G.Roddy Competition at the Concord Art Association. She recently was awarded Best Painting in the Arts Worcester Biennial, 2013 at the Danforth Art Museum.

This exhibition will be at Soprafina Gallery from May 3rd to June 1st. The gallery hours are Wednesday through Saturday, 11:00 AM to 5:00 PM.
